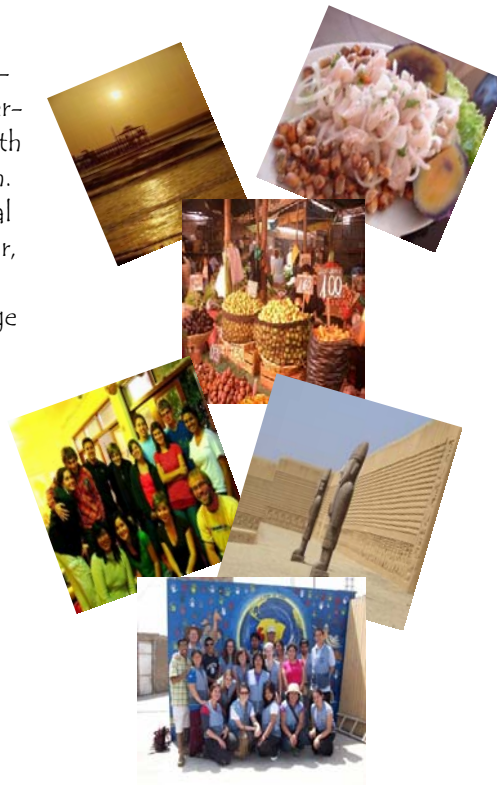

Volunteers can work on several different projects all run by SKIP. SKIP is interested in volunteers who like to work with children and speak at least some Spanish. The Volunteer can help in the additional afterschool classes, be an English teacher, or help with the nursery project. SKIP is also interested in volunteers over the age of 22 to help them with the secondary educational programme for children 12-18. The organisation would as well love to have someone to help with the additional activities like football for fathers or sewing with the mothers.

The Volunteer will either stay in the main house, together with 11 other volunteers from different countries, or they can stay with a family in the local area.

Accommodation and Meals

About the place

Peru is located on the West Coast of Latin America, surrounded by Ecuador and Colombia in the North, Brasilia in the East and Bolivia and Chile in the North. The West coast of Peru lies at the South Pacific Ocean. Due to the Peru's nature the country a dramatic regional diversity and living, health and educational standard are unevenly distributed throughout the country. Half of the Population lives in the highlands which makes the development into a single society problematic. While the people that live in the city adapt to Western lifestyle, the rural population of the Andeans lives traditional and farms by hand their own land. Peru has a rich cultural diversity but the gap between the rich and poor is distinctive.

Climate: The climate varies in the different areas in Peru. Northern Cost between 14 °C– 38 °C ,Central and southern cost from 8 °C – 35 °C June—August is the dry season, although it rarely rains for more than a couple of hours. In the Andeans the temperature can drop under -10 °C.
