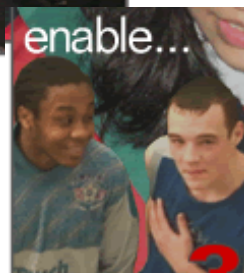




European Volunteer Service

Bradford Foyer

The key objective of the Foyer is to provide a coordinated and engaging approach to meeting the needs of young people aged 16-25 years, who for a variety of reasons are unable to live at home. Bradford Foyer aims to help young people make the transition from dependence to independence in a planned way and at a pace suited to their individual development and operates campus style accommodation for 64 people – approximately 40 who are supported and the remaining 20 are low support units, where they may stay for up to two years. The volunteers time will be split, partly spent working directly with residents, supporting them in general Foyer/ community work, such as budgeting skills and preparation for independent living. The rest of the time will be spent on activities of choice, within the local community.

Accommodation & Meals

Volunteers receive pocket money to buy food. Initially this is weekly in cash until we help you open a UK bank account. Volunteers working in this project will either live at the Foyer—two volunteers sharing a self contained flat or, will live in Everything's Possible accommodation which has a kitchen and all utensils and equipment needed to prepare meals, television & stereo (that may be shared between two flats). Volunteers will share a flat or house with other volunteers in Leeds or Bradford. You may need to use a bicycle to get between the accommodation and the project, we can provide you with this. The accommodation is non-smoking and not all flats have a shower, some only have a bath. Long-term volunteers normally have their own bedroom but may have to be share with another volunteer for a short period.

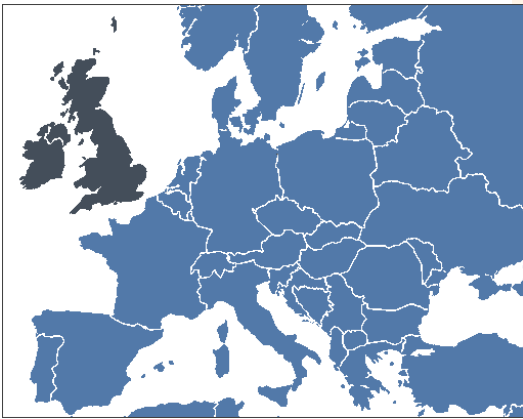
