This project works in partnership with Phoenix Dance—a contemporary Dance Theatre based in the centre of Leeds. Volunteers will have the chance to work in one or more of the following areas:

- 1.– Dance education—taking contemporary dance workshops to school groups.
- 2.– Audio & Lighting—supporting the stage team with practical aspects of phoenix's annual dance tour.
- 3.– Marketing—there may be opportunities for volunteers involvement in promoting the activities & tour of Phoenix Dance to schools, education & community arts organisations.

Accommodation & Meals

Volunteers receive pocket money to buy food. Initially this is weekly in cash until we help you open a UK bank account. The accommodation you will live in has a kitchen and all utensils and equipment needed to prepare meals and also a washing machine, television & stereo (that may be shared between two flats). Volunteers will share a flat or house with other volunteers in Leeds or Bradford. You may need to use a bicycle to get between the accommodation and the project, we can provide you with this.

The accommodation is non-smoking and not all flats have a shower, some only have a bath. Long-term volunteers normally have their own bedroom but may have to be share with

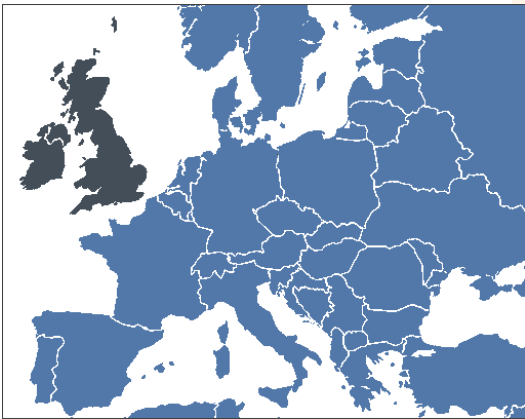
