- 1.- Supporting an after school clubs in arts, sports, drama etc. and introducing cultural activities.
- 2.- Supporting teachers and volunteers in the school and breakfast club.
- 3.- Supporting playground activities & lunch time in the dining room and playground.
- 4 - There will be a chance in this project to supervise educational visits and organise activities around your own country/culture.
- 5 - You may have the choice to work in a secondary placement, which could be a high school or a different community project.
- 6 - During school holidays you will work in play-schemes, holiday clubs or Everything's Possible Youth-camps alongside staff and other volunteers

Accommodation & Meals

Volunteers receive pocket money to buy food. Initially this is weekly in cash until we help you open a UK bank account. The accommodation you will live in has a kitchen and all utensils and equipment needed to prepare meals and also a washing machine, television & stereo (that may be shared between two flats). Volunteers will share a flat or house with other volunteers in Leeds or Bradford. You may need to use a bicycle to get between the accommodation and the project, we can provide you with this. The accommodation is non-smoking and not all flats have a shower, some only have a bath. Long-term volunteers normally have their own bedroom but may have to be share with another volunteer for a short period.

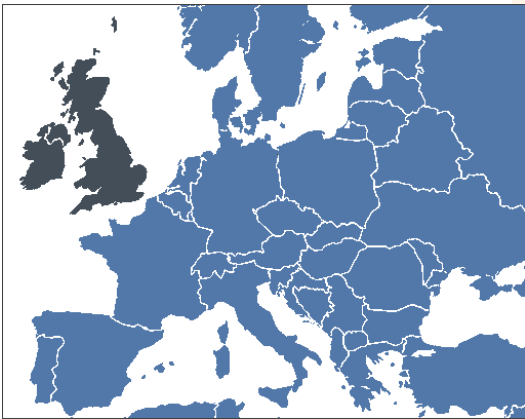
